ACTIVE INGREDIENT: Contains 360g/litre glyphosate as the isopropylamine salt in the form of a soluble concentrate

PRECAUTIONS: Keep out of reach of children. Read label completely before use. Store in original container away from foodstuffs. Avoid contact with skin and eyes, and avoid breathing in the spray mist. Wear eye protection, waterproof gloves, long trousers and closed in boots when mixing and spraying. Wash hands and exposed skin thoroughly after use and before eating. Store in original container. Do not contaminate aquatic environments with concentrate, spray or empty container. In the event of spillage, prevent the liquid from entering waterways. Absorb spill with soil. **Keep children** and pets off treated areas until spray has dried. Not for use on or near food or animal feed crops.

FIRST AID: If swallowed DO NOT induce vomiting. Give plenty of water to dilute. For advice, contact **The National Poisons Centre 0800 POISON** (0800 764 766) or a doctor immediately. If skin or hair contact occurs, remove contaminated dothing and flush skin and hair with running water. If splashed in eyes, wash out immediately with water.

STORAGE: Store in original container, tightly closed, securely away from children and foodstuffs.

DISPOSAL: Dispose the empty container with domestic rubbish after triple rinsing and adding the wash to the spray mix.

GENERAL INFORMATION: When used as directed Weed Out™ weed killer controls a wide range of annual and perennial weeds such as Dandelion, Couch, Paspalum, Kikuyu Grass and Thistles. Weed Out™ weed killer is absorbed through the leaves and moves within the plant and into the roots, controlling the plant above and below ground. Weed Out™ weed killer has no soil activity only treated weeds will be affected. For applications prior to planting gardens or lawns, allow 7 days to pass from treatment before sowing. Apply all year round to actively growing annual weeds. For perennial weeds delay application until there is 15cm or more of leaf growth. Do not cultivate weeds for 7 days after treatment, to allow time for Weed Out™ weed killer to circulate throughout the weeds system. Rainfall occurring up to 2 hours after application may reduce effectiveness, necessitating a repeat treatment. Visible brown–off may take 7-14 days.

DIRECTIONS: Spot treat weeds in lawns carefully as Weed Out™ weed killer will kill lawn grasses. Avoid contact with desirable plants and trees. If accidentally sprayed, hose off immediately to reduce injury. Some hard to kill weeds such as Kikuyu may require repeat spraying.

APPLICATION: Mix 10ml per 1 litre of clean water. Spray emerged actively growing weeds ensuring all leaves are wet.

WIPER APPLICATION: Premix 100ml per 200ml of dean water, then fill the applicator. Ensure wiping area of applicator is wet before starting and
